## 4. Consideration of Names Proposals on Pending Review Lists

### Review List 416

- i. Region II (Assigned to McCrea)

*Damalusung Lake, Delmooah Valley, Delunga Peak, Seshme Creek,*

*Deferred due to lack of a response from Forest Service and the Maidu tribes. Maidu tribe has had unrelated diversion, but both Maidu and Washoe would like to participate.*

### Review List 428

- i. Region I (Assigned to Meyers)

*Oakland Hills Range*

*Deferred. Proponent has re-engaged so committee and BGN will move forward to contact local entities.*

### Review List 430

- i. Region II (Assigned to McCrea)

*Da-ek Dow Go-et (Mountain)*

Currently named Jeff Davis Peak, since 1889 on topographic maps. Proposal to change name to Da-ek Dow Go-et was put forth by Woodsford Washo Community (in response to a previous proposed change to Fred Bee Peak, which was withdrawn). Alpine County approves and USFS supports change but would like to add generic “peak” at the end.

Discussion: Da-ek Dow Go-et is translated to “a saddle between points”. The peak is a prominent volcanic plug on one end of a massif or mountain. The peak itself appears on a 1883 map as Sentinel Rock and is the subject of a proposed name change (see Review List 435, Region II).

The committee proposes that, with the agreement of all proponents and interested parties, the mountain be renamed Da-ek Dow Go-et, with the word “mountain” at the end, and the prominent rock outcrop be named Sentinel Rock.

*Approved 4-0, contingent that the following change will be agreed upon by the proponent. Specify the feature type as a mountain and not as a peak. Agree that*

*the name Da-ek Dow Go-et Mountain applies to the high points and their surroundings (as the Washoe name implies).*

## Review List 437

i. Region I (Assigned to Morrison)

*Lundbar Creek*

Proposed name for a previously unnamed 1.7 mile tributary of Martin Slough in Eureka. Proponent is the City of Eureka and is a counterproposal to Dog Slobber Creek (deemed inappropriate by the city). The new name honors two historical families of the area, Fred Lundblade Sr. (1891-1969) and Charles R. Barnum (1900-1953), who according to the proponent made significant contributions to the community. The stream flows through the municipal golf course. The adjacent residential community is named Lundbar Hills and includes Lundblade Drive and Lundbar Hills Park. There is strong local government support for the proposed name.

*Recommend approval 4-0*
